Rev. Marisa Brown Ludwig, MSW, MDiv is an ordained minister in the Southern New England Conference, United Church of Christ (UCC) and has most recently served as Associate Pastor at First Church of Christ in Longmeadow, UCC, from 2013-2022. Marisa has served as Vice President of the Interfaith Council of Greater Springfield and serves on the SNEUCC Task Team on Ecumenism and Interfaith Relations (Chair 2012-2018). She is active in issues of Racial Justice, LGBTQ Rights, Climate Change, Women's Rights/Reproductive Justice and hosted a weekly interfaith Coffee & Conversations locally for more than 6 years. She received a MICAH Award in 2020 from the Pioneer Valley Project. Marisa is a licensed social worker, with a 15-year career in medical and mental health settings, including being director of a mid-size community mental health center in Holyoke for ServiceNet, Inc. for six years. While working full time and raising two boys with her husband Peter, she attended seminary at both Hartford Seminary and Andover Newton Theological School, with special emphasis on Women's Spirituality and Interfaith/Ecumenical Relations.
