### **Roof Project Status**

The total cost of the roof project was \$78755.76. The Phys Ops Endowment allotment of \$10,000 (for 2024 and 2025) is allocated to this project. In addition a portion of the bequest from the Vieira estate of \$51068 was used for the roof repair. To date \$9539 in Shingle Sponsor donations was raised! The roofing work was paid off but we still need to raise \$8148 to cover the cost.
