

"News for the Pews" for the Week of December 21, 2025

The Church will be closed **December 25th** through Thursday January 1st for the holiday. Deb will be back in the office on Monday January 5th. Rev. Janet will be on vacation from December 29 through January 5th. In the event of an emergency please contact Rev. Janet or notify the office.

On January 4th the Rev. William Ault will lead us in worship.

Year End Pledge Reminder: As we approach the end of the year, there are two worship service dates left in 2025. This prompts this reminder regarding the IRS rules that we must follow regarding reporting of gifts, from which there can be no exceptions.

To qualify as a gift for tax year 2025, the gift must be either:

- 1) if mailed, be postmarked on or before Wednesday, December 31, 2025, or
- 2) be delivered during church office hours by Wednesday, December 24, by the time the church office closes (1:30 P.M.), or
- 3) be placed in the offering at either of the worship services on Wednesday, December 24 or on December 28th.

Further, if the gift is a check, the check must be dated on or before December 31, 2025.

We must point out this example: a check dated on or before December 31 that does not meet the criteria listed above will be counted as a gift received in 2026. If made to fulfill a 2025 pledge, it will be noted and appear as "Pledge – Prior Year" in the 2026 accounting.

The Fellowship Commission would like to remind our church membership that **pledge cards** for 2026 can still be turned in. If you have forgotten to turn yours in, please do so as soon as possible. We're already entering the budgetary process for the new year and knowing our expected pledge income is a key part of that planning. Just a friendly reminder – if you are a "one and done" pledger – your check is gratefully received, but we'd still like to receive a card from you for our bookkeeping purposes. If you need a card they are available in the Narthex or you can see Deb in the office.


